

# WHAT TO TAKE TO CAMP BARTLE

\_\_\_ Spending money – turn in to

\_\_\_ Lunch money in pocket at Church and everything below

## CLASS “A” SCOUT UNIFORM (wear to travel to Camp Bartle)

- \_\_\_ Official Scout Shirt, Heart of America Council Patch, “59” troop numerals, rank insignia (required)  
\_\_\_ Shorts (required), either official Scout shorts or plain shorts  
\_\_\_ Troop neckerchief & official or other slide (required to have, pack in box)  
\_\_\_ Merit Badge Sash (optional)  
\_\_\_ Scout belt (optional)  
\_\_\_ Scout socks (optional)

## CAMP UNIFORM (CLASS “B”) (wear daily in camp)

- \_\_\_ Camp Bartle, Camp Naish, Troop 59, High Adventure or other Scout T-shirt  
\_\_\_ Scout shorts or plain shorts

## REQUIRED ITEMS (mark with Scout’s name and “Troop 59”)

- \_\_\_ Camp box, footlocker or trunk with COMBINATION lock (Box approx. 16” W x 32”L x 13”H)  
\_\_\_ Socks (at least 5 pair, more is better)  
\_\_\_ Underwear (at least 5 pair, more is better)  
\_\_\_ Swim trunks  
\_\_\_ Extra T-shirts  
\_\_\_ Hat or cap  
\_\_\_ Pajamas or sleeping shirt & shorts  
\_\_\_ Towels (1 or 2 bath size, 1 hand size, 1 wash cloth) – don’t send good ones!  
\_\_\_ Hiking boots or tennis shoes (NOT expensive ones)  
\_\_\_ Raincoat or poncho  
\_\_\_ Flashlight and extra batteries  
\_\_\_ Boy Scout handbook  
\_\_\_ Pocket knife with folding blade only  
\_\_\_ Pocket notebook, pen and pencil  
\_\_\_ Work gloves  
\_\_\_ Jeans or long pants (1 pair)  
\_\_\_ Sweatshirt  
\_\_\_ Drinking cup  
\_\_\_ Sleeping bag (sheets and/or light blanket optional)  
\_\_\_ Ground pad (to place on cot)  
\_\_\_ Pillow with case  
\_\_\_ Shirt - large, old long-sleeved button up front; old belt; old long pants (not jeans) - Required for all Scouts who have not already completed Life Saving Merit Badge  
\_\_\_ Mosquito repellent (NON-AEROSOL) recommend Avon Skin-So-Soft/sunscreen  
\_\_\_ Toilet articles in a ziplock or shaving bag  
\_\_\_ Soap & shampoo  
\_\_\_ Toothbrush & Toothpaste  
\_\_\_ Comb or brush  
\_\_\_ Deodorant (please!)  
\_\_\_ Razor and shaving cream, if needed  
\_\_\_ Contact lens case and solutions, if needed

## OPTIONAL ITEMS

- \_\_\_ Bible or prayer book  
\_\_\_ Camera (disposable is best) and film  
\_\_\_ Sunglasses & spare eyeglasses  
\_\_\_ Small rug or carpet square  
\_\_\_ Snacks  
\_\_\_ 10 feet of nylon line, clothes hanger, clothes pins  
\_\_\_ Biodegradable clothes washing soap (1/2 cup powder in ziplock bag)  
\_\_\_ Stationery with pre-addressed/stamped envelopes  
\_\_\_ Book to read, Board game, cards, chess, checkers etc.
